Function word before the name of a branch of human endeavor or proficiency; before the name of a commodity or any familiar objects of daily life to indicate reference to the individual thing, part, or supply thought of as at hand. Used as a function word before singular noun to indicate that the noun is to be understood generically * to indicate reference to a group as a whole.

A twin tower. Singular, like the shade of space

between them. I. A blink of an eye has more fundamental moments than there are atoms in Mt. Everest (Brian Green, string theorist).

First sound in alphabets. Used before a mass noun to denote a particular type of instance. Used as a function word with nouns to form adverbial phrases of quantity, amount, or degree.

Before singular nouns when the referent is unspecified and before number collectives. Locked space.
